Updates from Finance

- New Mileage Rate: Beginning January 1, 2011, mileage will be 51 cents per mile.
- Vacation Policy Update: After your second missionary renewal, you will now be eligible for six weeks paid vacation instead of four.



January is a time for new beginnings, and with each new beginning, like each new year, we're allowed to start fresh and dream big. Dreams and goals are important, but if we want to see them become reality, we have to do something. We must ask the Lord for His guidance, His provision, and His wisdom in our lives and ministries.

To that end, I would like to invite our entire U.S. Missions family to participate in the Daniel Fast this January. The Daniel Fast is a 21-day partial fast based on Daniel's own experiences as recorded in the Bible. The purpose is to restrict commonly enjoyed foods as an act of worship and consecration to God.

The fast will begin on January 13, 2011, and end on February 2, 2011. We will post devotionals and video messages on our Facebook page from AGUSM staff members participating in the fast to help encourage you. We'd like this to be an interactive time and encourage you to post your testimonies and encouragement on our Facebook page, too. There are several online resources and Web sites that provide in-depth information about the Daniel Fast, daily devotionals, and even recipes for "Daniel Fast approved" meals. I know the Lord will bless your time of fasting and I am excited to hear your testimonies! Remember the words Paul wrote in 1 Corinthians 2:9 (NLT), "No eye has seen, no ear has heard, and no mind has imagined what God has prepared for those who love him."
